Chapter 1

Jesus, God's Answer from Above

healed and delivered. Hear what he says of himself in John 10:10 and John 3: 15

The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly. John 10:10

And no man hath ascended up to heaven, but he that came down from heaven, even the Son of man which is in heaven. And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of man be lifted up: That whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have eternal life. John 3:13-15

Numbers 21:5-8 gives account of the event that Jesus referred to here, thus:

And the people spake against God, and against Moses, Wherefore have ye brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? for there is no bread, neither is there any water; and our soul loatheth this light bread. And the LORD sent fiery serpents among the people, and they bit the people; and much people of Israel died. Therefore the people came to Moses, and said, We have sinned, for we have spoken against the LORD, and against thee; pray unto the LORD, that he take away the serpents from us. And Moses prayed for the people. And the LORD

said unto Moses, Make thee a fiery serpent, and set it upon a pole: and it shall come to pass, that every one that is bitten, when he looketh upon it, shall live.

Jesus is the one whom the Father lifted up as the solution to all plagues of mankind.

Jesus is the sent word that heals and delivers from every destruction. Psalm 107:18-20 shows this when reconciled with the truth of John 1:1-3.

Fools because of their transgression, and because of their iniquities, are afflicted. Their soul abhorreth all manner of meat; and they draw near

**unto the gates of death. Then they cry
unto the LORD in their trouble, and he
saveth them out of their distresses. He
sent his word, and healed them, and
delivered them from their
destructions. Psalms 107:17-20**

**In the beginning was the Word, and
the Word was with God, and the Word
was God. The same was in the
beginning with God. All things were
made by him; and without him was
not any thing made that was made.
John 1:1-3**

The word that was sent to heal them
who were afflicted, who were drawing

near to the grave, who called unto God in their trouble and distress, the Bible revealed in John 1:1-3 that it was Jesus. He is the Word. Matthew 8:16-17 makes it clearer:

When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick: That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses. Matthew 8:16-17

Jesus today is God's remedy for sicknesses and diseases. He it is who

took the sicknesses and diseases of humanity as he bore their sins and nailed all up on the cross. He healed all that came to him -- that believed in him -- because he is the one whom the father has sent to bear humanity's sicknesses, diseases and sins.

Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed. 1 Peter 2:24

He it was who tasted death for every man. He it is who will save you from untimely death. He died your death that you may live his life.

But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that he by the grace of God should taste death for every man.

Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

Hebrews 2:9;14-15

He is God's fulfilment of what God said in Exodus 23:25.

And ye shall serve the LORD your God...and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee. Exodus 23:25

It is by him God has taken away sicknesses and diseases from the midst of his covenant people, because he is the fulfilment of Isaiah 53:4-5.

Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. Isaiah 53:4-5

And through whom the Scripture is thereby fulfilled that none shall say in Zion, which is the Church, that I am sick.

And the inhabitant shall not say, I am sick: the people that dwell therein shall be forgiven their iniquity. Isaiah 33:24

Jesus is the ransom from death, sickness, diseases, evils and all destructions for mankind. The Bible buttresses this truth thus:

He is chastened also with pain upon his bed, and the multitude of his bones with strong pain: So that his life abhorreth bread, and his soul dainty meat. His flesh is consumed away,

that it cannot be seen; and his bones that were not seen stick out. Yea, his soul draweth near unto the grave, and his life to the destroyers. If there be a messenger with him, an interpreter, one among a thousand, to shew unto man his uprightness: Then he is gracious unto him, and saith, Deliver him from going down to the pit: I have found a ransom. Job 33:19-24

This portion of Scripture makes it clear that the reason God would be gracious and say, "Deliver him from going down to the pit" would be because he has found a ransom. That ransom is His Son Jesus Christ -- Mark 10:45 reveals this fact.

**For even the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many.
Mark 10:45**

Jesus is our answer from God. He is the one whom God sent to be the propitiation for our sins.

Herein is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us, and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. 1 John 4:10

And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world. 1 John 2:2

Chapter 2

Looking unto Jesus

They looked unto him, and were lightened: and their faces were not ashamed. Psalms 34:5

Looking unto Jesus the author and finisher of our faith... Hebrews 12:2

Having established that Jesus is the answer from God for all our ordeals, let me share with you what now to do to come out of the ordeal. This is what to

do: turn to Jesus with the understanding that he is God's sent answer to you and look to him. You may have been praying over the issue but you have not really turned to Jesus with the understanding that the answer is he and he has already been given to you. He said in Matthew 28:20, "...lo, I am with you always." And in John 15:5, "...without me you can do nothing." Tell Jesus directly, what the situation is. He is the sent help from above. When wine got exhausted at the marriage feast of Cana in Galilee, Mary turned to Jesus and said to him, "They have no wine." Jesus responded by given them miraculous wine better than the one they had bought with their money.

Jesus is God's help sent to you and I, and acknowledging that fact and talking directly to him, the answer sent our way, is key to enjoying solutions to life problems.

A woman whose daughter was sick asked John Alexandaner Dowie, when he told her that Jesus would heal her daughter, how he knew that Jesus was present there with them in the room. Dowie showed her Matthew 28:20 where Jesus said, "Lo I am with you always". When the woman believed, he prayed for the girl and she was healed instantly.

You have to look unto Jesus for breakthrough, healing, health, deliverance, salvation, peace, restoration, etc. The Bible says, looking unto Jesus the author and the finisher of our faith. Look to him personally. Let Jesus be real to you. Address him in faith. Trust him. Depend on him. He will never put you to shame. No matter the situation, let your faith express itself through patience where necessary. You have God's answer to you in the person of Jesus: you have the solution in your hands. Pray and trust him. Things must change-- he is the answer. There is nothing he cannot do and he is the answer to your prayer. Jesus is the same

yesterday, today and forever. Read through Matthew, Mark, Luke and John of the Bible and see the miracles he did. That is exactly what he does. Have faith in Christ.

This is what he says in John 14:13-14

And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.

This statement is settled in heaven -- he will do it! Forget that negative medical report. Jesus doesn't use it. Something is going on in the realm of the spirits. Jesus is a spirit, the devil is a spirit. Medical instruments can't discover spirits. Turn

your mind to the spirit realm and see Jesus give you the victory over your condition. The devil can't stand him. Physical circumstances can't either. He won the victory even before you were born.

Now call upon Jesus. Call him like blind Bartimaeus did in the Bible (Mk 10:46-51); he will show up in that situation!

If you are not yet a Christian, repent and turn to God today. You can't reject God's answer and yet get solution. There is no other name given under heaven by which we can be saved except Jesus (Act 4:12).

Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved. Acts 4:12

He is God's solution to a dying world. Accept Jesus into your life today. He knocks at the door of your heart according to his word in Revelation 3:20

Behold, I stand at the door, and knock: if any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me. Revelation 3:20

Give your life to him completely, let him be Lord of all your affairs. His salvation

is open to you today. Make this decision today by saying this prayer:

Lord Jesus, for too long I've kept you out of my life. I know that I am a sinner and that I cannot save myself. No longer will I close the door when I hear you knocking. By faith I gratefully receive your gift of salvation. I am ready to trust you as my Lord and Savior. Thank you, Lord Jesus, for coming to earth. I believe you are the Son of God who died on the cross for my sins and rose from the dead on the third day. Thank you for bearing my sins and giving me the gift of eternal life. I believe your words are true. Come into my heart, Lord Jesus, and be my Savior. Amen.

Congratulations if you have just said this prayer with a heart of repentance and faith. Now Jesus is with you. Locate a Bible believing Church while asking Jesus to guide you into one. Tell the pastor or the Christian leaders there of your decision so you can get further guidance on how you can grow in your relationship with God and his Son Jesus Christ.
